Recycling and Refuse Collection

- The City of Harrison is pleased to announce that each residential household will be issued one roll-out Blue polycart with Green lid for trash and one that is Blue with a Yellow lid. Yellow lid cart is strictly for recycling. Delivery of the polycarts is scheduled for the first three weeks of December.
- For both trash and recycling pick-up you must place the carts so they are accessible to our collection equipment. The carts should be placed no less than 2 feet from the gutter. Remember the carts should not block the driveway or mailbox and placed on street side only. The goal is for the polycart(s) to be placed so they can be emptied safely. Safety applies to both our trucks and your property. They will be picked up with automated equipment/trucks.
- Waste that is not placed in the polycart or any waste that is overloading the cart will not be picked up. Please make sure the cart is placed properly for servicing.



- Containers are the property of Inland Service Corporation. Each container is numbered and assigned to a specific resident. You are accountable for these containers. When you move, these containers must remain at your current address.



There are two options of Service

Base Residential Service

- **Trash Service**—Once a week collection with a **64 gallon** blue cart with green lid, and one bulk item per month (such as a piece of furniture but no White Goods).
- **Single Stream Recycling Collection**—Once a week collection with a 96-gallon blue cart with yellow lid.
- **White Goods/Bulky Waste Collection**—Once per year City-wide, curbside collection in the Spring as scheduled by City and Inland Service Corporation.

OR

Low Volume Residential Service

- **Trash Service**—Once a week collection with a **35 gallon** blue cart with green lid, and one bulk item per month (such as a piece of furniture but no White Goods).
- **Single Stream Recycling Collection**—Once a week collection with a **96-gallon** blue cart with yellow lid.
- **White Goods/Bulky Waste Collection**—Once per year City-wide, curbside collection in the Spring as scheduled by City and Inland Service Corporation.

What are White Goods/Bulky Collection?

ACCEPTED BULKY WASTE AND WHITE GOODS

- Furniture, Mattress and Box Springs, non-Freon containing appliances, toys, tools, bicycles (no tires), push/selfpropelled lawn mowers (no oil/gas), clothes, metal (short lengths), carpets (cut, rolled into four (4) foot lengths), fencing, lumber cut into four (4) foot lengths

UNACCEPTABLE BULKY ITEMS

- Tires of any kind, batteries, paint, liquid waste, construction material, automobiles/parts, appliances containing Freon, dehumidifiers, guns and ammunition

Recycling made EASY!

Effective January 2013 The City of Harrison is recycling! You will recycle using a 96 gallon blue roll-out cart with yellow lid. Recycle items can be placed together (comingled) in the same container.

WHAT CAN BE RECYLED YOU ASK?

Paper & Cardboard



Newspaper, Magazines, Cardboard, Office Paper, Cereal Boxes & Telephone Books,, Brown paper bags, shredded paper (bagged)

Plastic Bottles & Jugs



#1 PET Soda Bottles, #2 HDPE Milk Jugs and Detergent Bottles, plastic #3 PVC, #4 LDPE, #5 PP, and #7 plastic

Metal Cans



Tin, Bi-metal, pie tins, clean aluminum foil and Aluminum Cans



Recycling Tips:

- To reduce your carbon footprint, don't bring it to the street if it is less than half full
- Place at the edge of the street no later than 7:00 AM on your scheduled day
- Check plastic items for acceptable triangle codes
- Lightly rinse containers
- Crush cans and plastic bottles to save space

Not Acceptable Items:

Wax-coated Cardboard, Pizza Boxes, Medical Supplies, Glass, Styrofoam, Oil, Batteries, Light Bulbs, Carpet, Juice Cartons, clothing, plastic toys, Food-contaminated Items, Paper Towels or Tissues, glass jars and bottles and Hazardous materials

DROP-OFF of RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

All materials listed for curbside pick-up to include glass (bottles and jars) are acceptable materials for drop-off at the Inland Service Corporation Drop-off facility located at: [508 Cottonwood Rd. Annex #1, Harrison, Arkansas.](#)

Hazardous Material

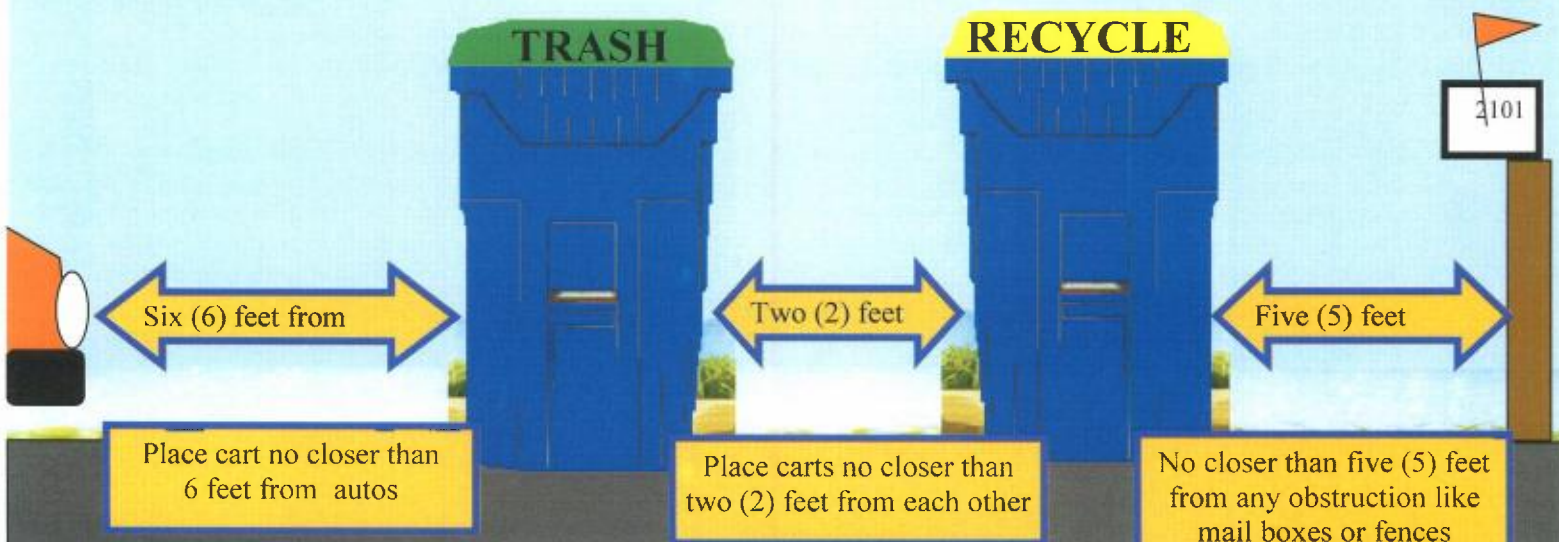
Hazardous materials include ignitable, corrosive, explosive, radioactive, reactive, or toxic wastes that may pose a threat to human health or the environment. The handling and disposal of these wastes are regulated by state and federal law.

EXAMPLES

Fluorescent light bulbs, lead-acid batteries, oils, oil filters, ordnance, explosives, needles, syringes, medical waste, tires, paints, solvents, pressurized gases, Freon, radioactive material, antifreeze, pesticides, herbicides, coals or hot ashes, guns, ammunition, to name a few

Helpful Hints and Reminders

- Your blue roll-out cart container with green lid must be used for household trash (food waste, rubbish, and non-recyclable items). The trash items shall be deposited in **tyed bags** before placement in your container to limit odors. Periodically wash your container with a diluted bleach and water solution to keep it sanitary. The blue roll-out cart container with yellow lid is for recycling only.
- Your container should be placed as close to the street as possible. When a container must be placed at the front or rear of a vehicle, the container must line up with the street side of the vehicle.
