## Council Meeting

November 29, 2018 – 6:00 pm

Mayor Sherrell called the Council Meeting to order.

### Approval of previous minutes:

The minutes from the October 25, 2018 Council meeting were presented to the Council for their approval. Council Member Creager moved to approve the minutes as presented. Council Member Williams seconded the motion. The vote was all ayes, motion carried.

After discussion, Council Member Magness moved to approve the resolution as presented. Council Member Williams seconded the motion. The vote was all ayes, motion carried.

ARDOT & City Partnership on Hwy 65 Corridor Improvements

As discussed in Committee, Mayor Sherrell asked the Council for their approval for the Mayor to send a letter to ARDOT offering to Partner with them on improvements to the City's existing bypass. After further discussion Council Member Williams moved to approve the Mayor to send a letter that would establish a partnership between the City of Harrison and ARDOT. The City would contribute \$2.5 million dollars to go towards improvements of the existing Hwy 62/65/412 Corridor through Harrison. Council Member Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The vote was all ayes, motion carried.

Mayor Sherrell then reminded the Council that the December meeting would conflict with the Christmas holiday. Council Member Creager moved to combine the Committee Meeting and Regularly called Council meeting to December 13, 2018, at 6:00pm in the Council Chambers. Council Member Williams seconded the motion. The vote was all aye, motion carried.
